

From a synopsis of the History of the family of Marr.

James Marr (1826-1897) Born at Smiths Creek N.B. son of Alexander, and grandson of another Alexander Marr who was born in Aberdeen, Scotland. James Marr married Mary Ann Graham in 1825. He was 19 years and she 17 years old. After their marriage they walked 12 miles to Jordan Mountain, carrying all their worldly possessions with them. The clothes they wore, an axe, sickle, a bushel of wheat and some buckwheat. The bride's clothes were all made by hand by her and her mother from shearing the sheep, carding the wool, weaving into cloth and sewing. Her shoes were made by her father. They chose a spot for their home and built a log cabin. Mary was very skillful in making medicine from herbs and tree barks, and was for many years the only doctor in that part of the country. Walking many miles summer and winter to help the sick. They had 12 children.

Flynn Marr, (1846-1926) born on Jordan Mountain N.B., 8th. son of James Marr. Alfred Flynn Marr married Lititia Esther Falkins and raised a family of 9 children on Jordan Mountain. When the family was grown they moved to a farm a mile to the east of Norton N.B. which was later farmed by his son Bliss and again later by grandson Leonard.
